### Procedure for Applications

Free Papers should be no more than 300 words, not including title/authors, and should be submitted electronically to Jan Brosnahan by **5pm Friday 19 February, 2010**. Email: [abstracts@nzssd.org.nz](mailto:abstracts@nzssd.org.nz)

Your email subject line should read:

**ABSTRACT – Authour’s name followed by abstract title EG: Abstract – Drury – Effect of metformin....”**

Your email attachment should be a Word document using the following settings:

- Arial Narrow
- Font size 10
- 1.5 Spacing
- Justified
- Title of paper should be **bold** and in **CAPITALS**.
- Name of presenter should be underlined
- Affiliation/institution should be in *italics*

The abstract should include:

- Title of the paper
- Author’s first name, surname & affiliation
- Presenter’s identity shown by underlining (if multiple authors)
- A brief statement of aims, objectives, methods, results and conclusions
- Tables may be included but must be included in the word count

In the body of the email please indicate your preference for oral or poster presentation, provide your full contact details, including postal address, daytime phone number and email address and a brief biography i.e. 2 sentences; please indicate if you have difficulties with particular dates or times.

**PLEASE NOTE:** All abstract and poster presenters are required to register for the conference. Online registration opens January 2010 on [www.akblimited.co.nz](http://www.akblimited.co.nz) Submitters are entitled to an early bird rate which closes on March 5, 2010 BUT you must register prior to submitting your abstract.
